AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CANFIELD CODIFIED ORDINANCE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DESIGNATED "COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA(S)" OF THE CITY		
WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance Number 180-40 the Council of the City of Canfield established the boundaries of the City's Community Reinvestment Area and		
WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Canfield desires to expand the designated Community Reinvestment Area pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3735.66 and		
WHEREAS, the maintenance and construction of structures in such area would serve to encourage economic stability, maintain real property values, and generate new employment opportunities, and		
WHEREAS, the remodeling of existing structures or the construction of new structures in this Community Reinvestment Area constitutes a public purpose fo which real property exemptions may be granted.		
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO;		
Section 1. That the boundary of the City of Canfield's Community Reinvestment Area ("CRA") shall be the municipality territorial limits so that the entire area of the City is within the CRA.		
Section 2. That a survey of housing and commercial structures has been conducted pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3735.65 et seq.		
Section 3. That the entire territory of the City is an area in which housing facilities or structures of historical significance are located and new housing construction and repair of existing facilities or structures are discouraged.		
Section 4. All properties within the designated Community Reinvestment are are eligible for this incentive. The proposal is a public/private partnership intended to promote and expand conforming uses in the designated area through the construction or remodeling and rehabilitation of structures within the designated area. As part of the project, the City of Canfield intends to undertake supporting public improvements in the designated area.		
Section 5. That this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.

	WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Canfield believes it to be necessary for the health, safety and benefit of the citizens of the City to amend Canfield Ordinance Chapter 513 regarding marijuana.
	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO;
	Section 1. That Canfield Codified Ordinance Section 513.03 (b) (1) (D) is hereby amended to read:
	"Any person who possesses the controlled substance pursuant to a lawful prescription issued by a licensed health professional authorized to prescribe drugs and is compliance with applicable laws relating to the possession or use of."
	Section 2. That Canfield Codified Ordinance Section 5.13.06 (a) is hereby amended tread:
	"Except as provided by the Ohio Revised Code no person shall knowingly cultivat marijuana."
	Section 3. That Canfield Codified Ordinance section 5.13.12 (a) is hereby amended to read:
	"As used in this section, "drug paraphernalia" means any equipment, product or materia of any kind that is used by the offender, intended by the offender for use or designed for use, in propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packaging repackaging, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling or otherwise introducing into the human body, a controlled substance in violation of this chapter of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 2925 except as may be authorized under the Ohio Revised Code. "Drug paraphernalia" includes, but is not limited to, any of the following equipment, products or materials that are used by the offender, intended by the offender for use, in any of the following manners."

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 901 "STREET EXCAVATIONS" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD

WHEREAS, the City of Canfield desires to implement a new permit and fee process regarding street excavations, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Canfield desires to replace current Canfield Codified Ordinance Chapter 901 as provided herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That Chapter 901 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Canfield is hereby amended to read as follows:

901.01 PERMIT AND FEE REQUIRED.

BARRETT BROTHERS - DAYTON, OHIO

No person or entity shall excavate, cut or dig into, through or under any paved street or any ditch or make any excavation within the boundary line of any street or highway within the Municipality until such person or entity has obtained a permit to do so from the City Manager, or his designee. The fee for obtaining a permit shall be as determined by the Council of the City of Canfield from time to time.

901.02 SECURITY REQUIRED.

Upon application therefor, the City Manager may issue a permit to allow excavating, digging or cutting upon, through or under any paved street or highway, when he has been furnished a bond or other sufficient security as determined by the City Manager from the applicant to secure such applicant's performance of all measures necessary to restore the street or highway, or property within the boundary lines of the street or highway, to its original condition after such excavating, cutting or digging has been completed.

901.03 NOTICE TO FIRE DEPARTMENT REQUIRED.

No person or entity shall dig any ditch or make any excavation, or cause any ditch to be dug or excavation to be made, on any public street or other public place without, before commencing to dig such ditch or make such excavation, first notifying the Cardinal Joint Fire District of their intention to dig such ditch or make such excavation.

901.04 EXPENSES.

If the City finds it necessary to obtain an inspection of the excavated or otherwise disturbed area(s), the applicant shall be required to pay for all costs related to said inspection. Such payment shall be due immediately upon notice of such costs from the City.

901.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
