AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 1183.02(A)(20) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Canfield desires to prohibit the placement of signs to attract public attention.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That new Section 1183.02 (a) (20) is hereby adopted as follows:

1183.02 (a) (20) Signs mounted on, painted on or affixed in any manner to a vehicle of any kind, or a trailer, parked on private property for the primary purpose of attracting public attention or directing the public to a use, business, event, product on the same property, or service are prohibited.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF WINDOW SIGNAGE

WHEREAS, the Zoning Inspection, City Manager and Law Director have recommended an amendment to Canfield Codified Ordinance Section 1183.03 to provide for regulations regarding window signage, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined such amendment is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Canfield,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That new Section 1183.03(j) entitled "Window Signs" shall be added to the Codified Ordinances of the City as follows:

1183.02(j) Window Signs.

Window signs placed within four (4) feet of a window, or directly on the window and visible to the outside shall not cover more than thirty percent (30%) of the window space between 4 feet and 7 feet above grade and shall not block views to any cashier area if one exists. Only seventy five percent (75%) of the total area(s) where letters are placed directly on windows shall count toward the maximum amount of allowable window coverage.

Section 2. That this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.
