## ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO THE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL ("NOPEC") AND THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF THE AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING NOPEC AND APPROVING THE BYLAWS OF NOPEC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Canfield wishes to establish an electric aggregation program pursuant to Section 4928.20, Ohio Revised Code (the "Electric Program"), and a natural gas aggregation program pursuant to Sections 4929.26 and 4929.27 of the Ohio Revised Code (the "Natural Gas Program"), for the residents, businesses and other consumers located within the City, and for that purpose, to act jointly with any other village, city, township, municipal corporation, county or other political subdivision of the State of Ohio, as permitted by law; and

**WHEREAS**, by joining the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council, the City will be able to act jointly with other member political subdivisions and thereby maximize the potential benefit of electric and natural gas deregulation through group purchasing efforts.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The Council of the City of Canfield finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City, including the electric and natural gas consumers located within the City, to join NOPEC and adopt the NOPEC Bylaws, for the purpose of establishing and implementing the Natural Gas and Electric Programs within the City.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement Establishing the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (the "NOPEC Agreement"). The NOPEC Agreement shall be substantially in the form presented to this Council and on file with the Clerk, subject to such changes, insertions and omissions which are consistent with this Ordinance and are not substantially adverse to the City and as may be approved by City Council, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the NOPEC Agreement.

**SECTION 3.** The Council hereby approves and adopts the Bylaws of NOPEC (in the form attached to the NOPEC Agreement).

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to maximize the potential benefit through the Electric and Natural Gas Program provided by NOPEC; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Council of the City.

APPROVING THE PLAN OF OPERATION AND GOVERNANCE FOR THE NOPEC ELECTRICITY AGGREGATION PROGRAM, FOR THE PURPOSE OF JOINTLY ESTABLISHING AND IMPLEMENTING AN ELECTRICITY AGGREGATION PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, this Council previously enacted legislation authorizing the City to establish an electricity aggregation program pursuant to Section 4928.20, Ohio Revised Code (the "Electricity Aggregation Program"), for the residents, businesses and other electric consumers in the City, and for that purpose, to act jointly with any other municipal corporation, township, county or other political subdivision of the State of Ohio, as permitted by law; and

**WHEREAS**, by joining the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council, the City will be able to act jointly with other member political subdivisions and thereby maximize the potential benefits of electricity deregulation through group purchasing efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council pursuant to Section 4928.20, Ohio Revised Code, has held two (2) public hearings on the Plan of Operation and Governance for the NOPEC Electricity Aggregation Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** This Council hereby approves and adopts the Plan of Operation and Governance of the NOPEC Electricity Aggregation Program (in the form presented to this Council and on file with the Clerk).

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to maximize the potential benefit through the Electric Program provided by NOPEC. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than four (4) members of Council; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A NATURAL GAS PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, under Section 4929.26 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Canfield, Ohio (the "City") is authorized to establish an opt-out natural gas aggregation program for the benefit of eligible natural gas consumers located within the City;

**WHEREAS**, under Section 4929.26 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City may exercise such authority jointly with other political subdivisions in the State of Ohio;

**WHEREAS**, governmental aggregation provides an opportunity for natural gas consumers collectively to participate in the potential benefits of natural gas deregulation through lower gas rates which they would not otherwise be able to have individually;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, MAHONING COUNTY, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The Council of the City (the "Council") finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City and certain natural gas consumers located within the City, to establish an opt-out natural gas aggregation program (the "Gas Aggregation Program") in the City, and to enter into a Natural Gas Program Agreement with NOPEC in order to establish a Gas Aggregation Program through NOPEC.

**SECTION 2.** The Council is hereby authorized and desires to execute and deliver the Natural Gas Program Agreement of NOPEC (the "Gas Program Agreement"). The Gas Program Agreement shall be substantially in the form presented to the Board on file with the Clerk, subject to such changes, insertions and omissions which are consistent with this Ordinance and are not substantially adverse to the City and as may be approved by the Council of the City, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by execution of the Gas Program Agreement.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City, wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Council.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH AN OPT-IN NATURAL GAS PROGRAM PURSUANT TO SECTION 4929.27(A)(1), OHIO REVISED CODE, JOINTLY THROUGH NOPEC AS A NOPEC MEMBER

WHEREAS, the City of Canfield, Ohio ("City"), has previously established an "opt-out" natural gas aggregation program pursuant to Section 4929.26, Ohio Revised Code, for its residents, businesses, and other consumers located within the City jointly through NOPEC as a NOPEC member; and

WHEREAS, to expand the natural gas supply options available to residents, businesses and other consumers within the City of Canfield, the City wishes to establish an "opt-in" natural gas aggregation program pursuant to Section 4929.27(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code (the "Opt-In Natural Gas Aggregation Program") for its residents, businesses and other consumers located within the City and, for that purpose, to act jointly with any other city, village, township, municipal corporation, county or other political subdivision of the State of Ohio, as permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to conduct the Opt-In Natural Gas Aggregation Program jointly through NOPEC as a NOPEC member.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY/VILLAGE OF CANFIELD, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby approves and authorizes the establishment of an Opt-In Natural Gas Aggregation Program in the City jointly through NOPEC as a NOPEC member and adopts this Ordinance pursuant to the authority contained in Section 4929.27(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Council of the City.

**SECTION 1.** This Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City, including the gas consumers located within the City, to adopt the Plan of Operation and Governance of the NOPEC Natural Gas Aggregation Program, for the purpose of establishing and implementing the NOPEC Natural Gas Aggregation Program in the City.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1183 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD AND TO ALLOW AND REGULATE CHANGEABLE COPY SIGNS

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Canfield has determined it to be in the best interests of the City to provide for and to regulate changeable copy signs, **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the City of Canfield;

**Section 1.** That a new subsection (h) shall be added to Codified Ordinance section 1183.03 as follows:

**1183.03(h) Electronic Changeable Copy Signs.** Multiple message and variable message electronic or digital signs ("Changeable Copy Signs" or "Signs") shall conform with the following requirements:

- (1) Full color Electronic Changeable Copy Signs shall be allowed with a black background.
- (2) Changeable Copy Signs shall be permitted in B-2, B-3, M-1, and S Zoning Districts except that no signs shall be permitted in the Historical District area as defined in Ordinance section 1129.01.
- (3) Messages shall remain fixed for at least 15 seconds.
- (4) Messages shall not spin, rotate, scroll, flash, or contain video displays, animation or intermittent light.
- (5) Changes to messages must be accomplished instantaneously without fading or other special effects.
- (6) Signs must be capable of regulating display intensity and the light intensity level of the display must automatically adjust to natural light conditions.
- (7) No sign shall be of such intensity as to create a distraction to motorists, or emulate traffic control devices.
- (8) Signs must contain a default design that will cause them to go dark if a malfunction occurs.
- (9) The changeable copy portion of any sign shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the total allowable area of the subject Sign.
- (10) Electronic or digital portions of such Signs must be turned off at the later of (i) when the subject business or subject owner is closed for business or (ii) 10:00 pm.
- (11) All Changeable Copy Signs shall include a photocell providing for dimmed illumination at night.

(12) One (1) Changeable Copy Sign shall be permitted per single property of unified site, i.e. a plaza.

(13) Upon (a) installation, or (b) at any time subsequent thereto upon the City's request, the owner shall provide the City with proof of compliance with the following illuminance requirement:

Illuminance shall be measured with an illuminance meter set to measure footcandles accurate to at least two decimals and shall be measured with the sign off, and again with the sign displaying a white image for a full color-capable sign, or a solid message for a single-color sign. All measurements shall be taken perpendicular to the face of the sign at the distance determined by the total square footage of the sign as set forth in the table below. The difference between the off and solid-message measurements using the measurement criteria shall not exceed 0.3 footcandles.

(15) At no time shall the total digital illumination area of a Sign fall below ninety-five percent (95%). If a sign falls below the 95% minimum illumination requirement, the sign shall be shut off until it is repaired and complies with the illumination requirement.

(16) Messages displayed must be static and complete in themselves, without continuation in context to another message or to another sign.

(17) Changeable Copy Signs should be limited to monument signs only.

(18) All Changeable Copy Signs must comply with all other applicable provisions contained in this Chapter 183.

**Section 2.** That Codified Ordinance Section 1183.02(G)(9) shall be and hereby is deleted and Section 1183.02(a) shall be renumbered accordingly.

A MOTION TO WAIVE A PORTION  
OF UTILITY CHARGES AT 255 RUSSO

WHEREAS, a business owner in the City of Canfield has asked City Council to waive a portion of the sewer charges; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canfield will waive the amount agreeable by the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer, not to exceed \$103.58
