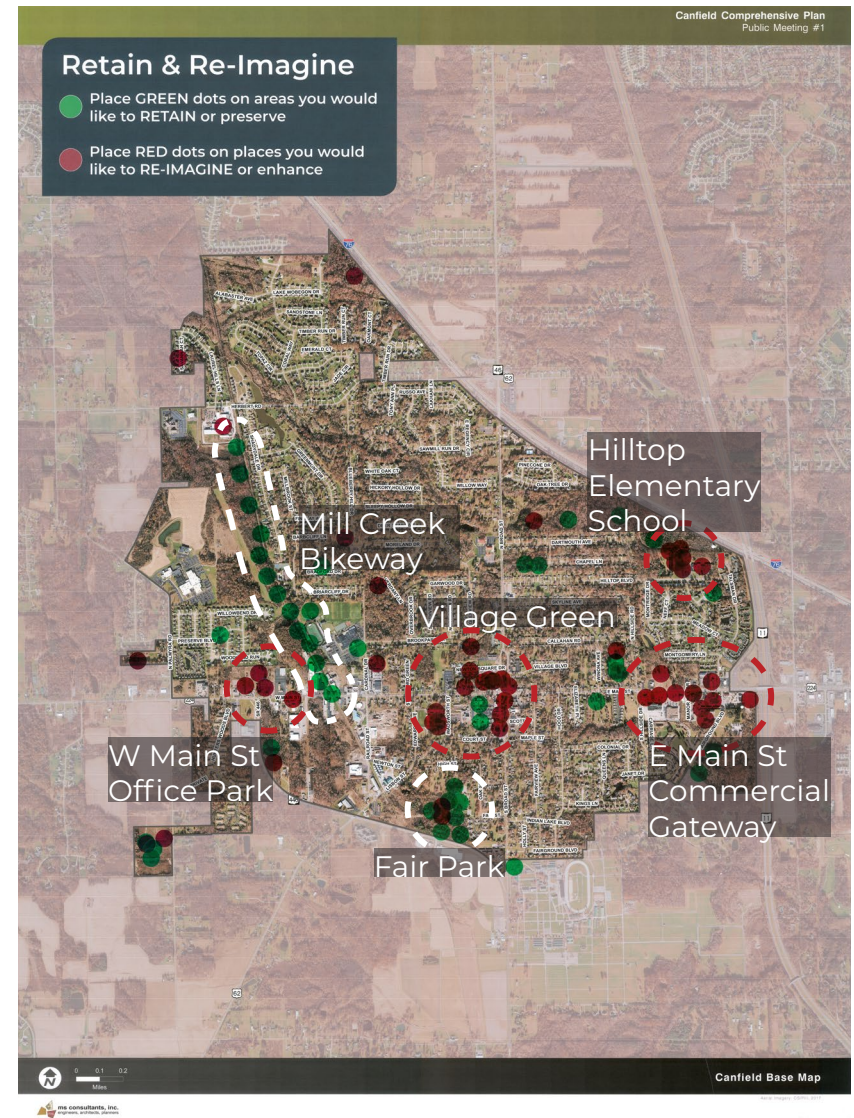

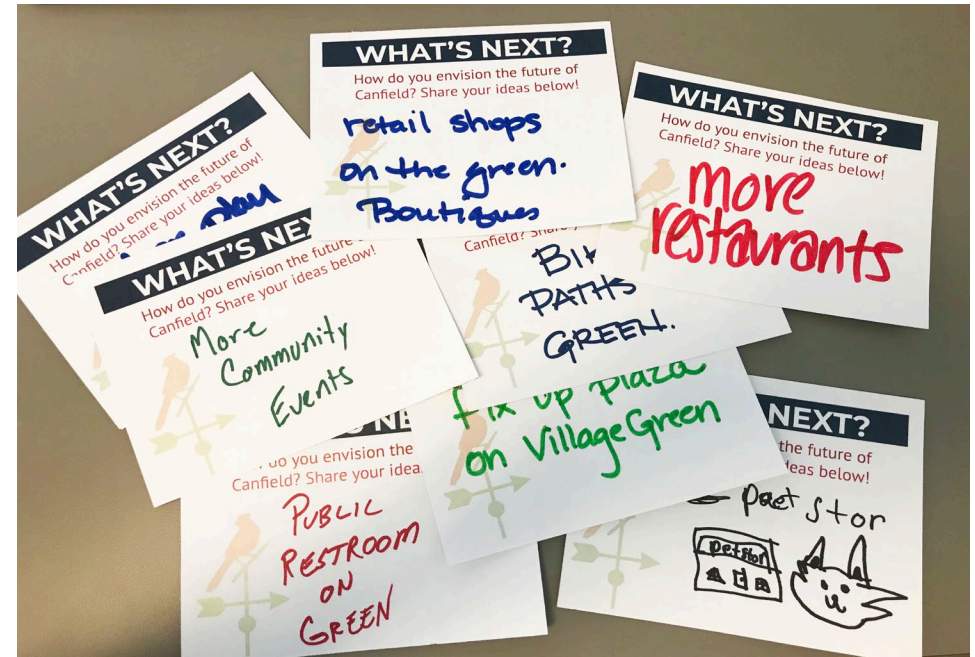

ACTIVITY: CROSS SECTION GAME

THE RULES:

- 1 You must fill all of your Right-Of-Way.
- 2 You may add green space to the Village Green, but you can't take any away.
- 3 You may change traffic to One-Way travel on either side of the Green.

ACTIVITY: CROSS SECTION GAME

FAQS:

- **What is Right-of-Way?**
 - » Public space between building fronts that the City maintains.
- **What are Mixed Use Buildings?**
 - » Buildings with shops and restaurants on the first floor and apartments / condos or offices on the upper floors.
- **What is a Sharrow?**
 - » Wider traffic lanes that allow bikes and cars to share the road.
- **What are the diagonal line pieces?**
 - » Buffers! These may be used to separate bike, parking, and travel lanes.
