**RESOLUTIONS OF THE COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD
SEEKING CERTIFICATION FROM THE AUDITOR
AS TO THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE GENERATED
BY 3.9 MILLS**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Canfield has determined that it is necessary to renew a levy a three and nine tenths-mill (3.9) tax outside the ten-mill limitation in order to continue to provide sufficient police protection to the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, the passage of these resolutions is required in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.03(B)(1);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Canfield finds it necessary to renew a levy to be placed on the November 3, 2026 ballot of an additional three and nine tenths-mill (3.9) tax outside the ten-mill limitation in order to continue to provide sufficient police services for the citizens of the City; and

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City of Canfield, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §5705.03(B)(1), hereby requests that the Mahoning County Auditor certify to the City the total current tax valuation of the City ("subdivision"), along with the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal of the three and nine tenths-mill (3.9) levy; and

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the purpose of the levy will be to provide sufficient police protection for the citizens of the City commencing in tax year 2027, first collected in 2024; and

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the submission of the question of the tax by the City of Canfield to be placed on the November 3, 2026 ballot is authorized by Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19 and 5705.07;

AND BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that these Resolutions and all deliberations relating to the passage of these Resolutions were held in open meeting of this Council, pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.
